

Battle of Chancellorsville

May 2, 1863

General T. J. Jackson executes a flank attack on the Union right. The resultant route enabled General Robert E. Lee to make a frontal assault on Union General Joseph Hooker's Army of the Potomac.

Post-battle terrain displayed a large number of abandoned boots left by Union soldiers. The newly issued footwear was not broken in which resulted in blistering the soldiers' feet.
