

# The Aorist Participles in Ephesians 6:14-17

The aorist adverbial participle usually denotes antecedent time to that of the controlling verb.\*

**Verse 14 - Stand fast [ἵστημι (*hístēmi*): main or controlling verb] **therefore, having buckled around your waist [περιζώννυμι (*perizōnnumi*): aorist adverbial participle] **the belt of truth and after having put on [ἐνδύω (*endúō*): aorist adverbial participle] **the breastplate of capacity righteousness, (EXT)********

**Verse 15 - **and having shod [ὑποδέω (*hupodéō*): aorist adverbial participle] **your feet with the preparation of the gospel of peace; (NASB)******
